**MEMORANDUM FOR ALL PAFB, CCAFS AND JONATHAN-DICKINSON MISSILE TRACKING ANNEX PERSONNEL**

**SUBJECT:** Limited Evacuation Order - Hurricane Dorian

1. This is a Limited Evacuation Order (LEO) for Patrick Air Force Base (PAFB), Cape Canaveral Air Force Station (CCAFS) and the Jonathan-Dickinson Missile Tracking Annex (JDMTA) personnel. Evacuees are authorized/ordered to move from a CONUS residence to the nearest Safe Haven as defined in par. 2d below. The authority for this LEO is located in the Joint Travel Regulations (JTR), par. 0601 (Evacuation Authority), par. 0602 (Allowances For Service Member's Dependents) and par. 0604 (Standard Allowances For Civilian Employees and Their Dependents).

2. Effective period. This order goes into effect 31 August 2019 at 0900L and remains in effect until an order to return is released or 28 Feb 2020 (6 months from evac order date), or when revoked by me or designee, whichever comes first. All evacuation (excluding mission essential) shall be complete by 1000L on 1 Sept 2019.

a. Evacuees. Defined as uniformed service members and their eligible dependents, all APF and NAF civilian employees and their eligible dependents whose permanent residence is located in the evacuation area. A member is ordered to depart the area in a temporary duty (TDY) or permanent change of station (PCS) status. Individuals assigned to Hurricane Ride Out Teams are not eligible for evacuation under this order, however, their eligible dependents may evacuate under this order. Personnel who are not designated as members of a ride-out team but who are deemed mission essential or required to remain by their commanders to perform mission-related duties will be excused from this evacuation order until they are cleared for release by their commander.

b. This order applies to all individuals assigned to, residing, or present on PAFB, CCAFS and JDMTA. The head of a defense activity or designated representative, or an official authorized under JTR par. 0601, seeking variance from the provisions of this order must coordinate with the Installation Commander and Base Emergency Operations Center Director before issuing contrary orders/guidance to his or her personnel. Variance from the provisions of this order will be in writing and included as an Annex thereto.

c. Evacuation Area. The evacuation area includes residences within Hurricane Evacuation Zones A-D as indicated at the included Florida Disaster link below, as well as all assigned personnel (and dependents) requiring special needs and whose primary

residence is a mobile or manufactured home. This link is the **only authorized source** to determine evacuation status and eligibility for reimbursement of evacuation-related expenses. All evacuation (excluding mission essential) shall be complete by 1000L on 1 Sept 2019. If the storm path changes we will reevaluate areas not evacuated at this time.

d. Safe Haven. A Safe Haven location is the nearest available accommodation, to include Government quarters, that is within a 500 mile maximum radius of PAFB and located out of the hurricane's projected track, or that is outside any Tropical Storm and Hurricane Warning areas, as identified by the National Hurricane Center. Mission Essential Personnel identified on the RECON II team roster are not to exceed a 350 mile radius to ensure a prompt return for recovery. Dependents of RECON II team members are exempt from the 350 mile restriction and may evacuate to the maximum 500 mile radius.

e. Evacuation Reason. **Hurricane Dorian**

f. Accountability. Individuals will, upon arrival at their Safe Haven (evacuation) location account for themselves and their dependents in their service's accountability system; or if not military associated, with their employer. If unable to access a computer at an evacuation location, contact the accountability system's number to report status and location. If personnel encounter issues with the use of their service's accountability system (i.e. freezing or other access issues), try launching the system in Google Chrome. If members still encounter issues using this alternate browser, call the numbers listed below.

3. Fund Citation for Orders and Reimbursement for USAF personnel will be provided by 45 CPTS; for non-USAF personnel, will be provided by the owning service.

4. Use of Government Travel Card is authorized. Personnel without a Government Travel Card (GTC) in need of an advance travel payment should coordinate with their servicing finance office. Those members and their dependents who do not have a GTC may use other payment means.

5. PAFB/CCAFS/JDMTA Evacuation: In the interest of protecting the security and mission of the installation, and the health, welfare, safety and security of all individuals present on the installation, as well as to support good order and discipline, all individuals (whether military affiliated or civilians) present on PAFB, CCAFS and JDMTA who are not mission

essential (and their dependents) or detailed to hurricane ride-out teams (not to include dependents) are also ordered to evacuate. This order covers all Federal property encompassing the 45th Space Wing, including but not limited to the Marina, FamCamp, and privatized housing on the Air Base. Individuals who attempt to ignore this order are subject to physical removal by all means necessary. Further, violation of this order renders the violator a continuing threat to the security and good order and discipline on PAFB, CCAFS and JDMTA. As such, in addition to physical removal, violation of this order subjects the violator to barment from PAFB, CCAFS and JDMTA for a period to be determined by the installation Commander, and potential prosecution under Title 18, United States Code, Section 1382.

6. For military members, failure to comply with this order is a violation of Article 92, UCMJ. DoD civilians in violation of this order may be subject to administrative discipline under applicable service regulations.
