MEMORANDUM FOR ALL PAFB, CCAFS AND JONATHAN-DICKINSON MISSILE TRACKING ANNEX PERSONNEL

SUBJECT: Termination of Limited Evacuation Order – Hurricane IRMA

1. As Patrick AFB Installation Commander, under the authority of Joint Travel Regulation (JTR) par C6010-B, I ordered an evacuation on 7 September 2017 for residences within Hurricane Evacuation Zones A-D, as well as all assigned personnel whose primary residence is a manufactured home.

2. As of 1215 on 11 September 2017, I am terminating the evacuation order and issuing a recall order, as designated below.

a. All personnel within 350 miles of Patrick Air Force Base (PAFB) are hereby ordered to return to your residence not later than 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time, 12 September 2017. At that time, all claimable travel, lodging and per diem entitlements will cease. I will approve any requests for exceptions to the authorized entitlements, due to extenuating circumstances, on a case-by-case basis.

b. All personnel who are 351 to 700 miles from PAFB are hereby ordered to return to your residence not later than 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time, 13 September 2017. At that time, all claimable travel, lodging and per diem entitlements will cease. I will approve any requests for exceptions to the authorized entitlements, due to extenuating circumstances, on a case-by-case basis.

c. All personnel who are 701 to 1000 miles from PAFB are hereby ordered to return to your residence not later than 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time, 14 September 2017. At that time, all claimable travel, lodging and per diem entitlements will cease. I will approve any requests for exceptions to the authorized entitlements, due to extenuating circumstances, on a case-by-case basis.

d. All personnel who are over 1000 miles from PAFB are hereby ordered to return to your residence not later than 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time, 15 September 2017. At that time, all claimable travel, lodging and per diem entitlements will cease. I will approve any requests for exceptions to the authorized entitlements, due to extenuating circumstances, on a case-by-case basis.

3. All affected members should report to their chain of command for further instructions.
