### Rules of Engagement

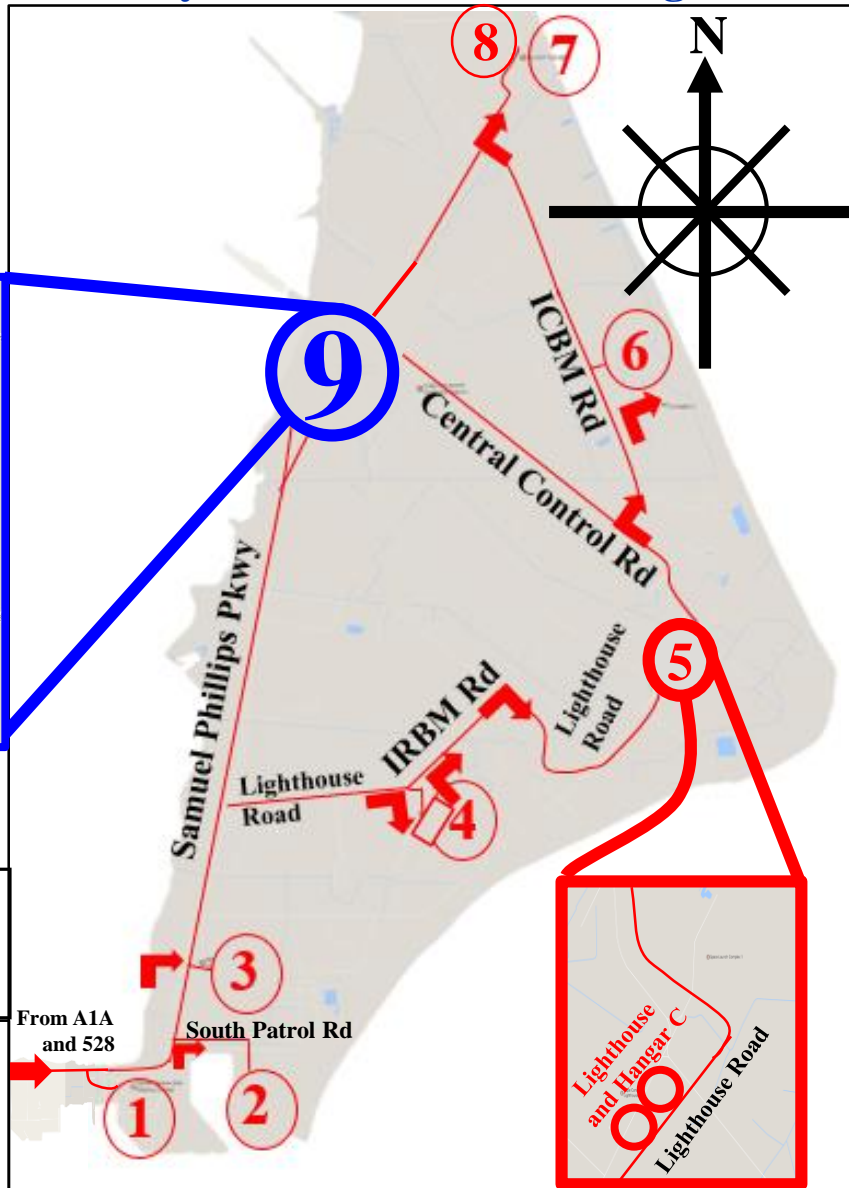
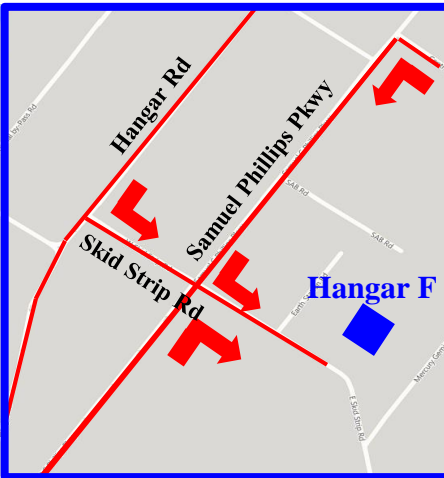
- **This is an operational base with many potential hazards. Stay on the authorized routes shown in red on the map. Beaches, unauthorized roads, and unauthorized areas or facilities are off limits; do not attempt to gain access to them. Immediately comply with any and all instructions given by base officials.**
- **Entry is allowed from 0800 to 1300 through the Cape South Gate ONLY. Cape Family Day ends and CCAFS will be cleared at 1400.** Rules are subject to change at any time without notice. Authorized facilities and routes are subject to change at any time without notice.
- **This event is open to persons badged for CCAFS access, CAC holders, and all US citizens and “green card” permanent residents they choose to escort. One properly badged person per vehicle is required for access only through the CCAFS South Gate.** That person is responsible for all personnel in party. **Tours of the facilities and the route are at your own pace.**
- **For fire, medical, and security emergencies dial 911 (853-0911 for cellular phones). Report crimes or minor incidents to 853-2121. Photography is authorized except for Entry Control Points of secured facilities (to include security personnel and security procedures).**
- **Pets are prohibited (to exclude service animals). Alcohol, firearms and other weapons are prohibited. Vehicles are subject to search and must obey traffic laws and the Florida motor vehicle financial responsibility law. All persons must use seat belts.**
- **Drivers may only use hands-free mobile electronic devices. Give right-of-way to all emergency and security responders.** Yield to wildlife on the installation and be cautious of dangerous wildlife. Listen to and obey any and all Public Service Announcements. 45 SW representatives and mission partners may be available to answer questions.
- **Phase 1 Lightning Watch:** If a Phase 1 Lightning Watch is announced over the PA, ensure that a building with wiring and plumbing, or a vehicle with a solid metal roof and solid metal sides is immediately available. Stay alert.
- **Phase 2 Lightning Warning:** If a Phase 2 Lightning Warning is announced over the PA, go inside the nearest building or vehicle immediately and remain there until the warning is terminated.
- **PLEASE respect handicap parking spots and areas!** These are not open parking spots for just anyone.
- **Budget 2 hours to see everything we have to offer!**

#### Outside the South Gate

##### 1. Sands Space History Center (RR, HS)

Check out the displays and history of Cape launch facilities, and remember to get souvenirs at the gift shop.

#### Inside the South Gate

##### 2. Naval Ordnance Test Unit (NOTU) Port (RR, OP)

Meet the Navy side of Cape Canaveral and learn about their ballistic missile tests.

##### 3. Morrell Operations Center (MOC) (RR, OP)

Join in a guided tour route of the seat of the 1st Range Operations Squadron and the 45th Weather Squadron.

##### 4. Air Force Space and Missile Museum (RR, HS)

Our very own on-base museum will be open for visiting. Attractions include the SLC-26 blockhouse, an exhibit hall, and a rocket garden.

##### 5. Cape Canaveral Lighthouse/Hangar C (RR, HS)

Climb up to Level 5 of the Air Force's only lighthouse and see the historic displays in Hangar C.

##### 6. The Blockhouse at SLC-14 (RR, HS)

Get an insider's look at the launch site of first manned US mission to orbit Earth.

##### 7. The Apollo Pad at SLC-34 (HS)

Visit the grounds of SLC-34, the site of the Apollo 1 tragedy that claimed the lives of three American astronauts.

##### 8. Photo Op of SLC-37 (OP)

Enjoy the opportunity to take photos of a ULA Delta Heavy on the Launchpad, which will be used for NASA's Parker Solar Probe mission.

##### 9. Hangar F (RR)

Come enjoy food trucks, a bounce castle, booths and exhibits from various Cape partners, and a photo-op with a twice-flown SpaceX Falcon first stage!
